The aim of the PPG is that it should be a representative group of patients that reflects the demographics of our patient population.

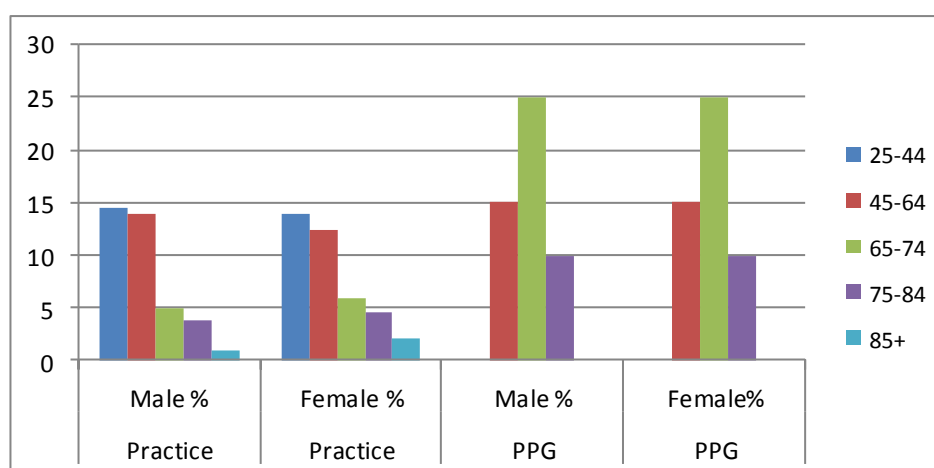
The original group was compiled following initial open applications following open advertising within the surgeries and on the practice website.

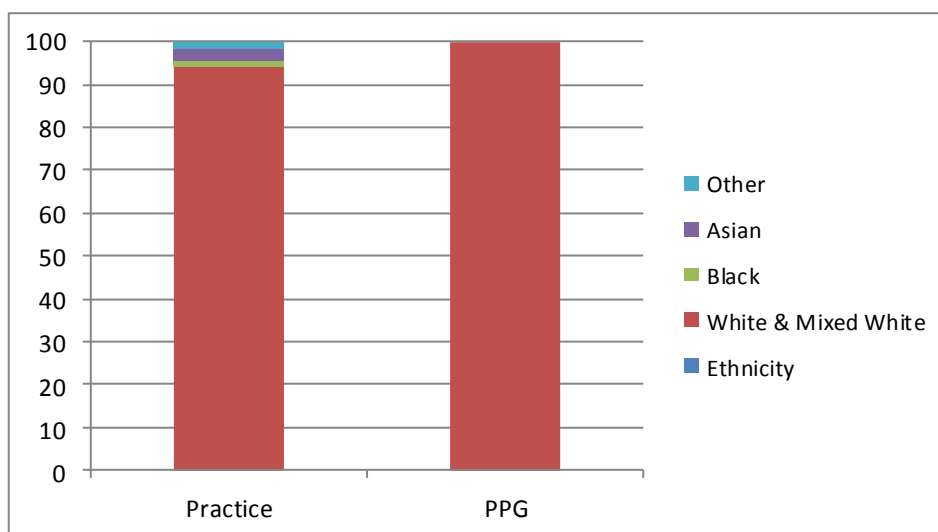
