TEST RESULTS

For your test results please telephone the surgery between 15.00-17.00 on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday.

On average please allow 2 working days for your test results to come back from the hospital unless your doctor has advised otherwise.

Please note that X-ray results take a little longer, usually 7 working days.

To protect patient confidentiality we will only give results to the patient who has had the test.

Calls are free from landlines and mobile phones.


NHS WALK IN CENTRE

APPOINTMENTS & SERVICES

ROUTINE APPOINTMENTS

- You can book routine appointments with the GP or nurse of your choice in advance either in person, by telephone or using the online access system.
- · Each routine appointment is of 10 minutes duration.

BOOK ON THE DAY APPOINTMENTS

- There are a number of book on the day appointments available each day.
- These appointments are limited and we ask you use these only for acute illness or issues that need to be assessed on the same day.

TRIAGE SERVICE

- · During times of peak demand we run a doctor triage service.
- During these times the reception staff will offer you a telephone appointment with one of doctors if you feel your condition can easily be managed by telephone.
- If the doctor feels that you need to come in for an assessment this will be arranged.

EXTENDED HOURS SURGERIES

- We hold extended hours surgeries.
- These surgeries are held on alternate Tuesday evenings between 18:30-20:30 at Broomhill Surgery.
- We also hold Saturday Morning surgeries between 08:00-12:30 and are alternate between both Broomhill and Lodge Moor surgeries.

THESE ARE AVAILABLE BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

HOME VISITS

- We provide home visits daily for patients who are housebound and unable to come to the surgery.
- We request that you contact the surgery before 11am if you require a
 home visit.
